When originally advertised in the mid-1950's, Lionel had a much different vision for the paint scheme on their 2240/2367 Wabash F-3's. The plan for was them to be much more like the real-life loco's with black underframe, silver trucks, white nose, long bottom and short middle white stripes, and tapered upper gray area. The prototype was painted this way and used in advertising (see other side of this page). Interestingly, the prototype A unit had the number 2240 on one side and 2367 on the other side. The actual production units had a much more bland paint scheme and the Lionel prototype went into the archives. In 2017, the prototype surfaced again when rock star Neil Young auctioned off part of his Lionel train collection. This item was part of that auction. 
