Captain Jeremiah O'Brien (1744–1818) was an Irish-American captain in the Massachusetts State Navy. He was in command of the sloop "Unity" when he captured the British armed schooner HMS "Margaretta" in the Battle of Machias, the first naval engagement of the Revolutionary War. In honor of the Bicentennial of the United States, Bangor & Aroostook GP7 #1776 (built as #573) was named the "Jeremiah O'Brien". This 100% Lionel made and decorated Scale GP-7 (product #2101190) contains all the standard LEGACY System features, including Bluetooth, dual motors, fan driven smoke unit, die-cast trucks, metal frame, sound system, etc., that Lionel is known for.
